MERSEA 20^{TH-}22ND SEPTEMBER 2023



ARRIVAL

- Children to arrive at school at normal time but enter school through the school office.

- They will need to be dressed in their clothes for Mersea.
- Please ensure they are able to carry all their bags themselves.
- Travel to Mersea in the morning via coaches.

AT MERSEA

- When we arrive at Mersea, the children will be allocated their tents.

- The children will spend very little time in their tents over the course of the three days.

- Staff will be staying on the same campsite, with at least two staff members awake at all times.

MEAL TIMES

- Children will need a packed lunch on the Wednesday.
- Children will be provided with a wide range of choices.

- Dinner will be provided on Wednesday . Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided on Thursday and breakfast and lunch will be provided on Friday.

- Please ensure we are aware of any dietary requirements if not specified on your child's medical form.

ACTIVITIES

- Throughout the three days, children will take part in seven different activities in their activity groups.

- These will not be the same for each child but can range from vertical obstacle courses, bush craft, kayaking, paddle boarding and high ropes courses.

- The staff at Mersea lead each of these activities but a member of school staff will be with each group.

- Activity groups will be different to tent groups but they may be with some of the same children.

- In addition, all the children will take part in evening activities organised by staff.
