Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are probably aware, we offer Year 6 an exciting residential at Ilam Hall Youth Hostel in the Derbyshire Peak District. We are already in the process of organising this year's visit which we have booked from **Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June to Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026.** It is a tremendously valuable and funfilled learning experience for the children and a memorable culmination to their time at West Leigh. It is a busy and **energetic** week, which will include:

- Hill walking in the Peak District National Park
- Mountain biking along the Tissington Trail
- A visit to the Blue John Caverns at Castleton
- Chatsworth House and Gardens
- A day at Alton Towers

You will understand that for the safety of all individuals, only children who demonstrate safe and responsible behaviour can take part. The children have been made aware that their place on this trip is dependent on their <u>sensible attitude and conduct</u> in school.

At present we estimate a cost of £380.00 which includes ALL food, accommodation, travel and activities. Accommodation at the youth hostel is limited and in order to secure a place for your child we require a deposit of £25.00. Places will be allocated according to payment of the deposit through Arbor. The trip deposit will be available on Arbor from 5.00pm on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> October. Should numbers exceed places, children will be placed on a waiting list in case others should withdraw from the trip. Payment of deposit should be completed by 4.00pm on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> November. Once your child's place has been confirmed, we will write to you with a list of instalment dates for the remaining payments. Should you wish to discuss the residential trip further, please do not hesitate to contact me. A meeting will be arranged in May to give parents detailed information about the trip.

For those children who choose not to go on the Ilam Hall residential, it is assumed they will take part in our exciting week of special activities based in the local Southend area.
