Citizen of the Week	Nominations	To help us when making our decisions, councillors would like to ask that nominations include enough detail. For example, if money was raised for charity – how/how much/which charity/why?
Tuck	Wider variety of tuck on offer	Following a recent suggestion, Mrs Rodger was invited to attend today's meeting so that we could discuss ways of improving tuck. Mrs Rodger explained that strict government guidelines have to be followed when selling tuck as food must not be high in sugar, salt or fat. Councillors made a number of suggestions to be added to the tuck shop which Mrs Rodger will investigate further: mangoes, vegetables (such as carrot, cucumber and pepper) and watermelon. It was suggested that dried fruit could be added to the menu. Mrs Rodger explained that this often has a high sugar content. She will explore the possibility of sourcing a dehydrator so that we can dry our own fruit, without the added sugar. Councillors have also asked if we can make our own fruit smoothies (so that sugar is not added).
Well-Being Week	Ideas needed	Ideas for 'Well-Being Week' were discussed and have been shared with Mrs London.
Pupil-Led Clubs	Applications to be completed	Mrs Carr explained that after the Christmas break, pupil-led clubs will begin. Clubs can only be organised by children in Years 5 and 6 but children from any year group are allowed to attend. Each councillor has been given 4 application forms to distribute to children in their class, once they have decided on a club idea; arranged for an adult to supervise their club and ensured that they have decided where the club will be held (checking the clubs timetable on the Council notice board if a hall is needed). When application forms have been returned, the School Council will decide which clubs will run in January. Successful club applicants will find out if their club has been selected on Friday 25 <sup>th</sup> November.
