Agenda Item Playground	Following a previous discussion about football and team games on the playground, Mr
Play Rota	Markham generated a revised rota to allow more children to get involved in
Play Kota	football/team games at break and lunchtime. The new rota, which has been trialled
	over the last few weeks, has allowed the girls more time to play football, as well as
	single year group slots and set days for a variety of other sporting games such as
	badminton, netball and basketball.
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	Following the trial, Councillors raised the following points:
	Having one year group at lunchtime has worked well – there have been fewer
	players and fewer balls making games easier to play
	Girls have had more opportunity to play which has been positive as
	the boys have finally accepted that the girls can play football
	Everyone loves the varied activity (e.g. badminton, netball and basketball) one day
	each week
	The boys get restless when it's not their day so they need something else to do that's physical
	Basketball needs monitoring more carefully as there is a greater likelihood of
	injury
	• Issue with rota where Year 5/6 have had extra time for basketball (due to weather
	issues). Therefore, could it be lower school on one half and upper school on the
	other half?
	Changing the rota between breaktime and lunchtime each day has been confusing.
	Mrs Carr will share these thoughts with Mr Markham so that the councillors ideas can be incorporated.
