Dear Parents/Carers,

11+ Practice Papers

Thank you for giving us warning that your son/daughter is going to sit the selection test. In order to give the children some extra practice, this is our plan. As you will remember from previous communications, we are not able to cover as much 11+ work in school as usual, as we are concentrating on recovering from lost learning during the pandemic.

On Friday 18th June, we will be sending home Pack 1 – a maths and an English past paper with answers. Please enable your child to try the papers in a quiet room. It is not necessary to set a strict time for the papers, but use approximate timing. It might be an idea to sit the papers on different days. It will be very helpful if you could mark the papers, so that the children know clearly where their weaknesses are. Please return the papers on Monday 28th June and there will be revision of skills during the following week, in class or groups.

Pack 2 will come home on June 28th and needs to be returned on Monday 5th July. Pack 3 will be sent home on July 5th and needs to be back in school on July 12th. It might be an idea to more strictly time the tests in Pack 3.

In the summer, there will be an offer of our 11+ Summer School. It will run on the mornings of August 17th, 18th, 19th from 10am-12pm at the school. The children will be split into groups and the West Leigh teaching staff will cover English and maths skills. We will send details on ParentPay next week.

Week 2 of the 11+ Summer School will have a different format.

Tuesday, August 24th will be a test experience workshop with the children sitting the pack of tests, under full test conditions, 9.30am – 12.30pm (inclusive of a break between the papers). The staff will then mark the papers and on Thursday August 26th from 8am – 12pm, they will give feedback to the children individually, and in groups.

Further details will be sent out via ParentPay.
