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The Human Digestive System

The main parts of the digestive system:	mouth, tongue, pharynx, oesophagus, liver, stomach, gallbladder, pancreas, large intestine, small intestine
The digestive journey of food:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Humans put food into their mouth. ⇒ Food is chewed by the teeth. ⇒ Food is swallowed and passed through the pharynx and oesophagus to the stomach. ⇒ In the stomach, it is mashed into a mixture like soup and mixed with acid. The mixture passes into the small intestine, where tiny bits of food pass into the bloodstream. ⇒ The food that is still left goes into the large intestine. ⇒ Finally, waste products leave the body.


Human Teeth

All about teeth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teeth grow in babies when they are about 6 months old • 20 teeth grow by the time you are about 2.5 years old • From about age 6 you start to lose teeth till about the age 12 • These teeth are replaced by 32 permanent teeth 	
Types of teeth	Incisors, canines, pre-molars, molars	

Jobs of different teeth

Molars and Pre-Molars These are back teeth for crushing and grinding food.	Canines Canines are long pointed teeth for grabbing food.	Incisors These are front teeth for snipping and cutting food.

What is a food chain?	A food chain is a diagram that shows a producer and consumers. A consumer can be a predator, prey or both. The arrow means - 'is food for'.
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
